Next week we will be celebrating CAD – Clean Air Day on Thursday 17th June. We have a number of exciting and informative events planned for the week. I would like to thank Luke and Simon who have been instrumental in helping us shape this day as well as the PTA for their support.

We are also very fortunate to have been offered a professional photographer from [Global Action Plan](#) to capture the events planned. A permission form will be sent to you as the images taken will be used outside of the school.

Activities planned for the week	
Assembly	Pupils will have an assembly on Thursday to explain what CAD day is.
Use of the garden area for story time	Every class will have the opportunity throughout the week to spend time reading outside and discuss what feels better – reading inside or out? Why?
Walk to school at least one day in the week	Every pupil will be encouraged to walk/ cycle/ scoot to school on at least one day next week although we do acknowledge that not all families live close by. If you take the bus to school, perhaps you could get off the bus a stop before the school one. If you travel by car, perhaps you could park it a few streets away and then walk to school. It would be amazing if every pupil in every class walked to school at least once during the week.
Science	In KS2, pupils will look at lichen on the trees in different parts of the common. Did you know that lichen is an indicator of the air pollution in an area? You can read more about it here .
Art work	One of our very generous parents is working with us to plan a variety of art activities with the pupils to mark CAD.
Bike Service – free offer	Dr Bike, a trained mechanic will come into the school during the afternoon to service the bikes of students, parents and teachers. We have set up a booking system. Please use the link for the booking system below. This will be on a first come, first serve basis. If you are booking a slot with Dr Bike during the school day, we will endeavour to bring your child out to be with you and experience the mechanic fixing their bike. We are looking forward to the events planned and hope that we can work together to improve the air quality for everyone.

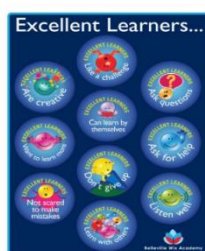
Future of our schools street - have your say!
