We have had a very busy four day week together. You may have seen pupils in reception dressed up as pirates this morning, our resident artists are working with Year 1 today and I have just waved Year 3 off on their trip to Kew Gardens. Here are some more highlights of our week.



Our Nursery pupils have been creating rockets as well as practising writing CVC words. They thought very carefully about the sounds they could hear in a variety of CVC words to spell them correctly with great results.

Pupils in RW have been exploring the life of a pirate. To create their own maps to send to the pirates in a bottle, they tea-stained the paper. They tested that the bottles they used would float in the water tray before using them.

1B have really enjoyed learning about Dinosaurs in History. As a whole class, they carefully observed a variety of fossils to identify different dinosaurs. They were also thrilled to know that dinosaurs once lived in England.
