



How do artists use drawing to make an image?



Taking inspiration from a detail of this impressionist artwork, the pupils in Year 1 developed their drawing skills to make a piece depicting a bird on a fence.





Year 2 looked Impressionist artist, Claude Monet. They learnt that styles of art have not always been the same and new ways of looking at the world can help us see beauty everywhere.



The pupils used careful observation to draw birds using basic shapes then adding detail and shading with pastels. They experimented with loose mark-making with ink and watercolour to create the impressions of a snowy, rural background.
