How do artists draw objects to show form?

Pupils drew peppers from observation and looked carefully at the lines and shapes they could see to represent the form of an object.



Year 3 looked at the colourful work of Yayoi Kusama to inspire them. They learnt that pumpkins were special to her when she was a child. We use peppers so we could see the light and shadow on a curved surface.



The pupils mixed complementary colours to make a colour darker and they used a range of media to make marks including; HB, 2B, 4B pencils, charcoal, chalk, fine liner and colour pencils.
