

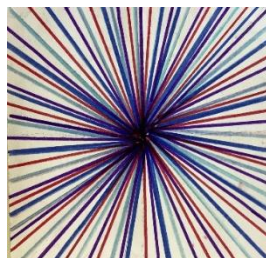

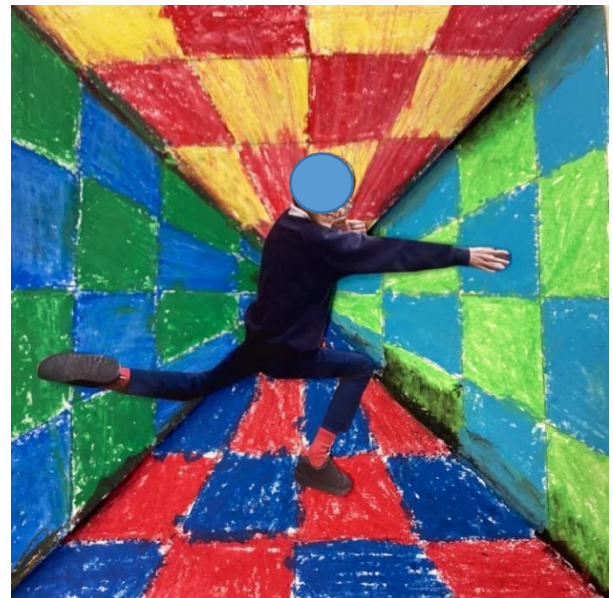

How do artists use a vanishing point?

The pupils were fascinated to discover how artists developed the use of a vanishing point to show perspective. They took photos of themselves to investigate what we see everyday.



Pupils explored the work of Paolo Uccello showing early perspective and other work from the 19th and 20th Centuries. To make their final piece, the pupils learnt about Bridget Riley and modern artists Sunny and Kai whose work plays with perspective in different ways.



The pupils drew their own vanishing point and used graded shading, making choices about colours by referencing the colour wheel. Using all the skills they learnt today, they created a piece with depth.
