Is BWA the right school for my child?

Welcome to BWA and thank you so much for your interest in our amazing school.

The decision about what school to apply for is such a hard one for parents but this has been made even harder for you all during a pandemic. Please be assured that we are here to work with you to help you get a good picture of what we offer every child at BWA and importantly, to get a feel for the BWA community. At our usual Open Days you would have a tour of our school, meet staff and current parents, followed by a talk by me.
