- ▶ Don't talk to strangers
- ▶ **Don't** walk with strangers
- ▶ **Don't** accept gifts, candy, or food from strangers
- ▶ **Don't** talk to strangers when they ask for directions, ask you to pet their dog or tell you a parent is injured or in an accident
- If ever approached by a stranger, tell a parent or an adult whom you trust
- ▶ **Don't** get into a car with strangers
- If you are approached by a stranger near your school, immediately return to your school and tell a teacher.
