## **RE: Home Learning Year 1- 6**

Our BWA Family Guide sets out what we aim to provide for pupils who have to self-isolate. Tasks set for pupils to work on at home will be based on the lessons which the class are doing in school, as much as possible, and gaps that have been identified. We aim to provide tasks for maths, English, reading, grammar, spelling and the wider curriculum – as set out below. This will be emailed if there are just a few pupils self-isolating. If a bubble needs to self-isolate, we will upload the tasks to seesaw. Pupils should upload their work onto Seesaw for the teacher to give feedback in all scenarios. To ensure there are as few barriers to your child accessing the work we need your help, please.

### **Maths**

Our scheme for maths is Maths No Problem. Pupils will be set work from the scheme therefore they need access to the online facility to use the textbook and workbook. Parents of pupils in yr 2 – 6 should be signed up already as you were invited to do this last term. New pupils and those in Year 1 will need to sign up. This is what we need you to do.

Your child will also be set weekly activities on Mathletics.

### **English**

#### **Reading**

Pupils should read every day. They should have the following books available to them.

- Guided Reading book
- Independent reading book

Your child should read every day with an adult and of course you know the impact of reading to your child is significant so please do try to find some time for this in your busy schedule.

#### **Grammar**

Your child will also be set weekly activities on spag.com.

#### **Spelling**

Pupils will be sent the weekly spellings to learn.

#### **Writing**

Our writing lessons are predominantly focused on the text the children are using in class. We don't have a copy for every child therefore we need to find solutions to this problem, dependent on the class and time your child may have to self-isolate. We may send your child home with a copy of the book, share a link to the book online or send the relevant pages to read. You may wish to order copies of the core texts that we will share with you in the curriculum presentations this week, so your child has their own copy.



## Wider Curriculum – Science, History, Geography, RE, Art

We are delighted to be teaching our new autumn term curriculum for all other subjects. Curriculum tasks will be based as much as possible on what the pupil would be learning at school.

### Seesaw
