	Clue: It is one more than 2.
	We are looking at number 3! Can you circle the number 3 on the number line?  (Resource 1).
	Today we are going to practice writing number 3. Use our number rhyme to help you! (Resource 2).
	Can you find any number 3's around your house? Maybe your door number is 3 or you can find 3 on your clock!

	Deepening: Can you find 3 of these objects: pencils, tops, cups?
Tuesday	Today we are looking at different ways to represent the number 3.
	We can represent the number 3 using actions! Can you try and show:

	We can also represent 3 with drawings! Can you draw:
	-3 stars
	-3 moons

	Deepening: Have I shown 3 squares? Why/why not?
Wednesday	We have been looking at 3 different numbers: 1, 2 and 3.
	There are so many ways we can show these numbers! We can use: fingers, dice, pasta and even write the number!
